Head-Heart-Hands project got its big boost from 12 to 14 November at the partnership meeting in Slavonski Brod, Croatia, where partners from Croatia, Slovenia, Germany and France met for the first time.

During the meeting, partners discussed the work plan, communication procedures and the use of storytelling and head-heart-hands as key project methods.

We took part in a hands-on podcast production training, introducing partners to planning, recording and editing audio materials.



Next steps

The partnership now moves into the research phase and begins preparing storytelling and intergenerational learning activities. We look forward to reconnecting at the next partnership meeting in Leipzig in March 2026.
